

## REQUEST FOR BIDS

The Worth County Board of Commissioners will receive sealed bids until 5:00 p.m. on March 16, 2017 at the Board of Commissioners' office on the third floor of the Worth County Courthouse located at 201 N. Main St. in Sylvester, Ga. for the following:

### **Fuel Management Equipment and Installation**

to include:

- Remove existing control system at Public Works
- Provide and install one new Fuel Control System unit at the fueling island (Must have ability to support a minimum of 150 Vehicles and be able to handle 600-800 transactions per month)
- Provide and install one new Wireless communication transaction system so that the Fuel System will connect to the network (Recording all transactions)
- Provide and install one new data logger or transaction printer
- Provide and install one new network interface card
- Provide and install one new software package on existing office PC for Windows
- Provide and install one new encoder on existing office PC
- Provide one hundred (100) control keys for vehicles
- Startup and test system for correct operation
- Train owner on system operation

OPTION: Provide additional training sessions as needed.

Bids will be opened at 7:00 p.m. on March 16, 2017 or as soon thereafter as possible in the presence of the County Commission, County staff, and all interested persons in the Commission Board Room. The opened bids will be read into public record, evaluated, and awarded at a County Commission meeting.
